Murder hornet nest found in america

The name homicide hornet strikes everyone with fear, but the bee population is most feared from this new sting threat. The Asian killer hornet was found in Washington state late last year and could spread to other states if not contained soon. Here's what you need to know: What are murderous hornets? Believed to be the largest hornet species in the world, the diet of killer hornets consists of large insects, but they especially like hornets and bees. The Queen comes out of hibernation time in April and eats sap and early spring fruits. When you build an underground nest and build a colony, a hornet of workers is dispatched in search of live food. Asian murder hornets attack beehives by biting off the heads of adults. Then they take over the hive to raise their own broods, using helpless bee larvae as food for their young. How did they get to America? They may have been deliberately exported or hitchhiked to foreign cargo. Asian hornets were seen in Canada in the fall of 2019 and first appeared in the United States near Blaine, Washington, in December 2019.
